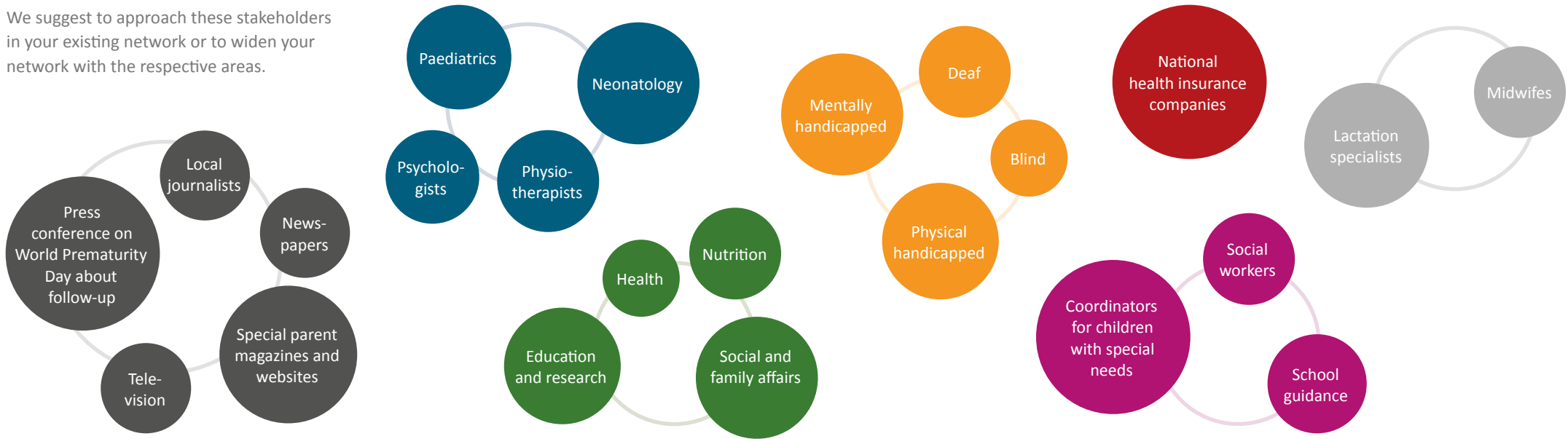




STAKEHOLDER MAP
